



Toddy Brook Golf Course – Golf Program Information

Established in 2001, Toddy Brook Golf Course is one of Maine’s “must-play” public golf courses. This par 71 course features five sets of tees, rolling hills, elevation drops of up to 150 feet, plenty of water, some of the best greens in the state, and presents a great round of golf for all levels of players.

Address: Toddy Brook Golf Course, 925 Sligo Rd, North Yarmouth, ME

Schedule: The Program starts at 9 am and goes on till noon. Please check your confirmation to ensure that you are confirmed for the given program day. Please arrive with enough time so that you can get yourself ready to start at 9 am and check in with staff when you arrive.

Where to meet: The group will have golf carts lined up on the outskirts of the parking lot. Make your way to the front of the line of carts where you will find the leading staff, who will match you to your team.

Teams will have access to the driving range, practice green, and be able to go out on the course. Each team should check with the Maine Adaptive staff or the course pro shop before going out on the course as depending on the timing you may be sent out on the front 9 or the back 9.

As a reminder to all, once on the course, we suggest playing best ball, which helps keep the pace of play moving.

Bathroom Facilities: The front entrance of the building has accessible restrooms on the main floor which can be accessed by either a ramp or a set of four stairs. The restrooms are to the right just before the kitchen bar.

What to wear: Golf attire is highly recommended and if you do not have attire, please try to dress with the appropriate clothing you have, such as collared polo shirts and no jeans.

Things we suggest you bring with you:

- water
- light snacks
- sunscreen
- bug spray
- layers (windbreaker, rain jacket or light layers in case it is cooler temps)
- closed toe shoes
- sunglasses
